Bridges is a web-based education and career planning program used in all Tyler ISD schools.

Bridges ignites the first spark of career awareness when students are still in elementary school with the “Paws in Jobland” portion of the Bridges program. By middle school, students start using Bridges' resources to identify personal interests, increase self-awareness, and explore all of their educational and career options. Students will create a personalized high school education plan called a “TAP” (Texas Achievement Plan) based on their interests and educational options. Students always have the option of changing their TAP, at any time, as their interests change.

Once in high school, students plan their coursework based on their interests, aptitude, and career goals for post-secondary education. All work is saved in a lifelong online portfolio as students make the transition from middle school to high school and beyond. Self-directed resources, in English and Spanish, guide all students and their parents on a learning path toward secondary and postsecondary success.
