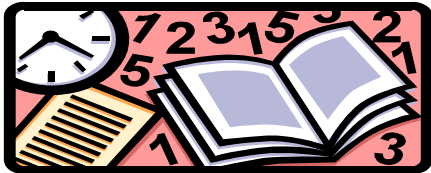


Special Interests

Unique Characteristics

- Emphasize preparation for a college preparatory, 5A high school.
- Offer Pre-Advanced Placement (Pre-AP) and accelerated classes in all core courses in all three grades.
- Embrace technology as a valid and essential tool for learning.
- Expect students to utilize Microsoft Word, Excel, Power Point, desktop publishing and other learning tools in six computer labs and on multiple computers in each classroom.
- Teach lab-based science emphasizing scientific method.
- Provide individual word-processing keyboards, which are used by every student to enhance writing skills.
- Insist that students are readers in preparation for higher level coursework.
- Offer Exploratory classes in Art, Spanish, Creative Living, Keyboarding and Industrial Technology, and a variety of mini-courses.

- Provide extensive support services on an individual basis to meet the specific learning needs of every student.
- Emphasize character development through monthly character words.
- Offer developmentally appropriate activities to serve the varied needs of 6th, 7th, and 8th graders.
- Communicate systematically with parents in a variety of ways.
- Encourage parent participation in school governance and PTA.
- Provide a safe and orderly environment.
- Require a standard code of dress.
