Dear Parents:

The Public Education Grant (PEG) Program, authorized under Texas Education Code, Chapter 29, Subchapter G, §§ 29.201 – 29.205 identifies campuses at which 50 percent or more of the students did not pass STAAR/TAKS in any two of the preceding three years or were rated improvement required in 2014, 2015, or 2016 under the statewide accountability system. The Texas Education code requires that each year districts notify parents of students on these campuses. The campuses identified in Tyler Independent School District include: Boulter, Dogan, and Hogg middle schools, Austin, Bonner, Dixie, Douglas, Griffin, Jones, Orr, Peete, and Ramey elementary schools.

Under the state's provisions, you are eligible to make application to attend a campus in another school district for the 2017-2018 school year. A school district chosen by a student's parent under this statute is entitled to accept or reject the application for the student to attend school in their district.

Additionally under the state's provisions, parents of students may request transfers within Tyler ISD only to another school that is not identified as a PEG school for the 2017-2018 school year.

Tyler ISD is committed to providing all students with a quality education, and to the continuous improvement of each school.
