

## Quick Reference - Criteria for At-Risk Identification –Elementary Schools

Several of the 13 state criteria for At Risk identification do not apply to elementary age students. The criteria that do apply are listed below with details for testing requirements.

1. Is in **HS, PK, K or grades 1 – 3** and did not perform satisfactorily on a readiness test or assessment instrument administered during the current school year:

**Headstart:** IDEA total raw scores equivalent to percentile ranks between 1-4

**Kindergarten:** score of < 7 on Kindergarten Reading Readiness Inventory

**Grade 1:** TPRI - score of < 8 on Screening I **OR**  
score of < 3 on Screening II **OR**  
score of < 5 on Screening III **OR**  
score of < 6 on Listening Comprehension (Story 1)

Math Readiness test score < 7

**Grade 2:** TPRI - score of <5 on Screening I **OR**  
score of score of < 6 on Reading Comprehension (Story 1)

**Math :** End of Year 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Assessment- score < 70  
(Revised 9.23.08)

**Grade 3:** TEKS Check Reading: score < 70  
End of Year 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade: score < 70  
(Revised 9.23.08)

2. *Criteria not applicable to elementary.*
3. Was not advanced from one grade level to the next for one or more school years.
4. Did not perform satisfactorily on TAKS initially or meet the 110% rule for subsequent administrations of TAKS/TAKS A. **(TAKS)**
5. *Is pregnant or a parent; (PAR) Parent (PREG) Pregnant*
6. Has been placed in DAEP during the preceding or current school year **(DAEP)** (not OCD or ISS)
7. Has been expelled during the preceding or current school year. **(JJ)**
8. *Criteria not applicable to elementary. (PRL) Parole/Probation*
9. *Criteria not applicable to elementary.*
10. Is a student of Limited English Proficiency **(LEP)**
11. Is in the custody or care of the Department of Protective and Regulatory Services or has been referred to the department by a school official, officer of the juvenile court or law enforcement official. **(DPRS)**
12. Is Homeless **(HOME)**
13. Resided in the current or preceding year in a residential placement facility in the district, including a detention facility, substance abuse treatment facility, emergency shelter, psychiatric hospital, halfway house or foster group home. **(RPF)**
