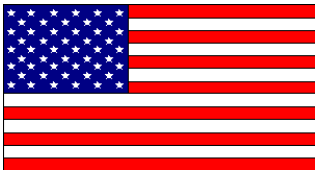

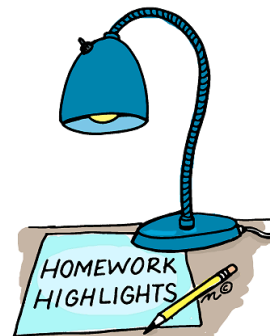

Suggestions on how to help your child at Home...

Using Reading Strategies when reading:

Picture Clues: Look for clues in the pictures that start with the letter of the unknown word.

Small Words: Look for small words in big words.
Ex: in the word 'pat' you can read the small word 'at'

Using Beginning Sounds: Start the word— say the initial sound and see if the word "pops" out

Problem Solving (Math)

- Ask your child a word problem— such as...
- If I put 5 cookies in your lunch box and you only ate 3 how many cookies do you have?
 $5 - 3 = 2$ cookies
- If there were 7 books on the shelf and 3 were on the floor. How many more books were on the shelf than on the floor? (4 more books were on the shelf than on the floor) $7 - 3 = 4$
