PURPLE POWER TEAMWORK
TALK TO YOUR TEAM

In order to make sure we are all achieving our goal of following the rules in our class, we have a teamwork plan called Purple Power.

1. Encourage your team
2. Remind your team to follow the rules
3. Choose to keep your power

Consequences:

1. *warning* - from the teacher to talk to your team members and help them get back on task.
2. *power is given up* – if the team does not get back on task with teamwork then they have chosen to give up their purple power stick for the day.
3. *sign the book and teacher conference* – If a student continues to break the rules they will conference with the teacher, the problem will be documented and the student will sign the book beneath the documentation.
4. *Talk to parents* – phone call or conference
5. *Office visit* – referral

Rewards:

Smelly hand stamp – teams who keep their power for the whole class

Purple Square on the chart – if the whole class keeps their power for the day

Game Day – four purple squares in a row on the classes chart
