

Medication Policy

PARENTS/GUARDIANS:

When a prescribed medication is to be given at school, it must be in the original container with a current Rx label that has the child's name, doctor's name and directions for administering the medication. The parent/guardian must also sign a consent form before it is given at school.

According to TISD policy, over-the-counter medications are not allowed to be given at school without a consent form signed by the child's doctor/dentist and the parent/guardian. In addition, students are not allowed to carry medications with them at school without written consent from the doctor and parent.
