



Caldwell Dress Code

Caldwell Arts Academy believes that our appearance should demonstrate our exceptional program. Although we do not have uniforms, we do hold our students to a high standard of dress that reflects our vision and the demand of our program. Below are guidelines that all students must follow to achieve this goal:

- All students must have appropriate dress for any arts program that they are participating in for the day.
- Symbols, words, lines or slogans may not be cut into the hair. Parents will be asked to have the design cut out if a child comes to school with one cut in his hair.
- Gang-related hairstyles, bandanas, or clothing are not permitted.
- Obscene language, tattoos, symbols, pictures or advertisements related to alcohol or drugs are not allowed on clothing, jewelry or exposed body parts.
- Body piercing, jewelry, and tattoos are not permitted.
- Improper wearing of clothing (sagging, excessively torn, backwards, inside out) is not permitted
- Tank tops, low cut clothing, or bare midriffs are not permitted.
- See through clothing, tight clothing, spandex tights and shorts (more than 3 inches above the knee) are not permitted.
- Excessive or distracting makeup and fake nails are not permitted.
- Flip-flops, or shoes intended for beachwear are not permitted.
- Hats and caps are not permitted inside the building.
- All shirts must be tucked inside jeans, slacks, shorts, etc.
