Shirts	Short or long sleeve Turtleneck Collared Shirts School approved TLMS and REL Spirit Gear Button-Up	Grey White Purple Black Gold Irish Green	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No denim. Revised 05/18 • No sleeveless, no cap sleeves. • Solid colors only. • No front logo larger than 2” by 2” with no logos on the back of the shirt. • If undershirts or camisoles are worn, they must be grey, white, purple, green, gold or black only, free of design or writing. • No see-through clothing of any kind. • Authorized TLMS or REL “spirit” shirts may be worn any day of the week.
Pants/Jeans/Shorts/ Dresses - Uniform style jumpers or dresses with a collar. No V necks	Denim jeans or shorts Capri Cargo Painter Gauchos	White Black Khaki/Tan Blue Grey	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Solid color. • Free of holes, tears, excessive fraying or excessive designs. • No jeggings. • Jeans/shorts must be worn at the waist and not excessively baggy or tight fitting. • No athletic style pants/sweatpants or shorts. • Shorts/Skirts/Skorts/Jumpers/Dresses: no shorter than 3” above knee in front and back. • All clothing must be hemmed.
Outerwear	Sweatshirts Sweaters Cardigans Jackets Hoodies	Grey White Green Black Purple Gold	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No logo larger than 2” by 2” with no logos on the back. • If hoodies/jackets/sweatshirts are worn during the school day, they must be predominately black, white, purple, green, gold or grey. • Any TLMS hoodie or jacket is acceptable. • Authorized TLMS or REL spirit hoodies may be worn any day of the week.
Shoes	Tennis Loafers Boots		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No house shoes/slides/flip flops. • All shoes must have a back or strap. • All shoes must be closed toe.
Miscellaneous	Hair Piercings Backpacks & Book Bags Hats/Toboggans Bandanas		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Facial hair on boys is not allowed. • Unnatural colors, slogans, or cut designs are not acceptable in hair or eyebrows. • No “non-traditional” piercings are allowed. (Example – nose/eyebrow piercings) • One “bag” per student. • Girls’ purses must fit inside backpack or book bag. • No backpacks or computer cases with wheels. • Hats/toboggans are not allowed to be worn inside any building.
