Fall Final Exam Schedule

Fall Semester Examinations Non-Exempt Courses:

- All EOC tested courses require a fall semester final examination (Algebra I, Biology, English I, English II, and U.S. History)
- Dual Credit/Technical Dual Credit courses: Students enrolled in a Dual Credit course may be required to take the associated semester examination for both college and high school credit. Grades awarded for college credit will follow the policies and procedures of the awarding institution.
- AP Courses require a fall semester final examination

Fall Semester Examination Exempt Courses:

Courses not outlined above as non-exempt, the Fall Semester examinations are given at the discretion of the teacher.

Attendance is required for all students during final examinations. Exemptions from finals do not exempt a student from their attendance requirement. If a student does not attend school during a final examination, their exemption status will be revoked and receive a zero for the final examination. At no time can the examinations be taken at an earlier date.

If a teacher chooses to give a final examination for fall semester, all students in the course are required to take the examination. The students who meet all of the criteria listed below, in a particular class, will earn the privilege of not having their semester examination included in their SW3 average.

- If the student is passing (70 or greater) and has 3 absences or less, per class, they are exempt.
- Students with disciplinary assignments during the semester to ISS, OSS, or DAEP are not eligible for exemptions.
- Any medical, college visits, or religious absences do not count- the student needs to provide adequate paperwork for these absences.
