Body Piercings

The **ONLY** visible body piercings allowed are small/medium earrings in ears for safety purposes.

Facial Hair, Hair Styles and Head Coverings

- Beards, goatees or mustaches must be neatly trimmed
- Distracting hair styles and/or hair colors are not permitted
- “Distraction” is subject to principal discretion.
- Headwear may be worn only for documented religious and/or medical reasons.



I.D. Badges

Must be worn at all times.

First I.D. is free. Replacements cost \$5 each. Lanyards are available for purchase.

Shirts, Jackets & Sweaters

1. Shirts must be one of the following:

- ❖ Have a collar in any color (polo, oxford, or dress style); or
- ❖ John Tyler HS spirit t-shirt; or
- ❖ College spirit t-shirt

2. Shirt tails must be at reasonable length around the natural waist (no long tees).

3. All tops must cover the midriff completely, at all times (pass the “reach test”).



Shorts & Pants

- Pants and shorts must be worn securely, at the natural waist.
- Sagging or exposure of undergarments is unacceptable. Pegged/rolled pant legs are prohibited. Pants with holes, rips, or tears are not permitted.
- Shorts **MUST** be worn below the knee (ex: bermuda or walking shorts)
- Warm-ups, windbreakers, or athletics pants/shorts are not permitted during school day. Athletes going to events must be in school dress code until excused to prepare to leave for event.



Skirts and Dresses

- Skirts, split skirts, and dresses must be below the knee and allow one to walk, stoop, kneel, and sit with modesty. If the dress is a high/low – the high part must be below the knee.
- Skirts/sleeveless dresses must be worn with a **collared** shirt, cardigan, or blazer with sleeves at all times.
- Splits must be no higher than 1 inch above the knee.



Undergarments

- Appropriate undergarments must be worn at all times.
- Undergarments should never be visible.
