

DAEP DRESS CODE

| All Students | <p>White uniform style shirt with collar with no logos.</p> <p>White plain undershirt (only wear one undershirt).</p> | <p>Uniform style pants in Khaki ONLY</p> <p>No Jeans (Denim) or Shorts</p> <p>MUST WEAR BELT (black or brown)</p> | <p>Black, grey, brown or white tennis shoes or black or brown dress shoes only.</p> <p>(No other colors: silver, gold, etc.)</p> |

- The dress code is the same for all students.
- Uniform style pants are pants that the back pockets can be pulled out.
- Variations from the above dress code are allowed for level 2 & 3 students.
- Shoes must not have colored logos other than black, grey, brown or white.
- Shoes that have metal tags in the shoe strings must have the metal tag removed.
- The shoe and belt requirement are the same for all levels.

Other Dress Code Expectations

- ▶ **All shirts must be tucked-in at true waist.**
- ▶ **Pants must be worn at natural waist. NO SAGGING**
- ▶ **Regular belt buckles; no large buckles, no letters or designs.**
- ▶ **Students may wear a white, long sleeve uniform style shirt when weather is cold.**
- ▶ **No hoodies, sweatshirts, coats or jackets.**
- ▶ **No shorts, capris' or crop pants.**
- ▶ **No athletic shorts are to be worn underneath uniform pants.**
- ▶ **No joggers, leggings, jeggings or excessively tight pants.**
- ▶ **No pants with the front pockets sewn shut.**

IF YOUR NOT SURE IF IT IS OK, THEN YOU MAY BRING IT UNWORN TO HAVE CHECK-IN STAFF REVIEW THE ITEM.

Other Dress Code Expectations

- ▶ All tattoos must be covered.
- ▶ No piercings and no spacers for piercings.
- ▶ No hats, caps, headbands or other head coverings.
- ▶ No jewelry of any kind is allowed.
- ▶ No hard, plastic or metal hair ornaments.
- ▶ No un-natural colors in hair or artificial hair (RED, BLUE, PURPLE...).
- ▶ No symbols, words or designs cut in the hair, eyebrows or in facial hair.
